## Food Technology

We will be learning lots about food safety this term. We are going to prepare and cook our own hot lunch, as well as some tasty snacks. We are also going to be making our own sweets later in the term.

Our R.E. this term will look at Jewish festivals and celebrations. After half-term we will be exploring the question - Was Jesus the Messiah?

## Maths

Y4 will be starting off by looking at place value with numbers up to 4 digits, comparing ordering and rounding these. We will explore properties of 2D shape as well as the 6,7 and 9 times tables.

Y5 will be starting off looking at place value with numbers up to 5 digits, comparing ordering and rounding these. We will be identifying, ordering and comparing decimals up to 3 dp as well as properties of 2D shapes

Y6 will also start by looking at place value but with numbers up to 7 digits, comparing ordering and rounding these. We will be exploring decimals up to 4 dp and then formal methods of multiplication and division for 2 digits by 4 digits.

## Art and Design

We will be exploring the artist Giuseppe Arcimboldo to create our own food portraits using colour mixing and collage techniques.
