I just wanted to send a quick note with a few bits of information.

PE – This academic year whole **class PE will be on a Monday** with progressive sports **and on a Friday** with Mrs Smith.

Times Tables Rock Stars – A copy of login details will be coming home again in the next few weeks. If you have any spare time at home, I can't recommend time tables revision and practise enough! It will help with every aspect of maths, especially for the new year 4s who will have their times table check in the spring!

Reading books – Children will have two reading books, their school (levelled book) and a reading for pleasure book. The levelled book has been selected to ensure your child is making progress in all areas of their reading; this includes accuracy, fluency, sensible speed and decoding. Their reading for pleasure book they have picked form our library and may be a book they want to read with you or on their own. **These need to be in school every day!** We have lots of time to read through our day and it's important that they have their books with them. It's especially important during upper KS2, with secondary school right around the corner for some, to ensure children are responsible for their equipment being in school each day.

Reading journals – This should have made it home to you earlier this week. It is a record of all the reading at home. The note in the front should show which day of the week I will be checking them and when your child's guided reading is. You can log any reading in there - school book, home reading book, the newspaper. The journal is there to celebrate your child's reading.

I hope everyone has had a wonderfully happy and restful summer. We've had a great few days in class and I'm really excited to see what the rest of the year will bring!
