OPAL playtimes- Every day the children have OPAL playtimes. Please can the children have a raincoat and over trousers in school every day, and a pair of wellies.






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Mathematics:

Reception-

- Recognise and order numbers 1 to 10.
- Develop composition skills.
- Use 'more than', 'less than' and 'equal to' to describe quantities.
- Explore and compare mass, weight, capacity, length and height.

Year 1-

- Understand addition and subtraction facts (7 to 18).
- Use mathematical language to describe position and direction.
- Measure and compare lengths.

Reception- Understanding the World

Year 1- Science

Reception will be naming different animals and learning about animals that live on land and in the water.

Year 1 will be learning about carnivores, herbivores and omnivores. Also, they will be classifying and naming animals that are mammals, amphibians, reptiles, fish and birds.

Year 1- Art

In Art we will be learning about the artist Jon Burgerman. We will develop our colour, shape and line skills as well as exploring pencil and pen.
